3	<p><b>LPT PERFORMANCE REVIEW</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Priorities            A lot of work is currently being done around, cuckooing involving vulnerable adults and children and cross border criminals            A fortnightly meeting has recently been set up to focus on cross border crime. This has resulted in a number of arrests of people from West Midlands.            There has been a National spate of theft of Nitrous Oxide (laughing gas) with cannisters stolen from Cannock hospital</li> </ul>	

	<p>and local dentists. Cannock officers arrested 7 people disrupting an organised crime group.</p> <p>Officers were involved in rescuing two people from a house filled with fumes of carbon monoxide. This resulted in saving the life of one of them. The officers have been nominated for an award.</p> <p>An online surgery has been arranged for 22<sup>nd</sup> May giving the community chance to ask Cannock Chase Police questions. Sarah gave an overview and explained that Transformation needed to happen due to increase in demand and crime type and financial pressure. Sarah and the LPT are the Neighbourhoods and Partnerships team indicated on slide 3. LPT now consists of 6 Sgts 22 PCs 19 PCSOs 2 IOs (investigative officers)</li> </ul>	
4	<p><b>LOCAL PERFORMANCE MATTERS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Questions/Answers Q: There has been a recent rampage in Rugeley of 13 incidents of smashing windows. How is the investigation going? How can the public be better informed? A: One person has been arrested and released under investigation. Generic details are able to be shared with the public. The information is on the LPT Twitter page and is shared at the Cannock Chase Community Safety Hub. Q: Is there going to be an increase in LPT in Norton Canes? There appears to be currently no one. A: LPT Laura Bainbridge will now be covering Norton Canes. Sarah to ask Laura to contact Parish Council clerks Linda Florence (Norton Canes) and Ray Smythe (Heath Hayes) to introduce herself. Q: The budget for Drugs and Alcohol abuse has been reduced by £5million. Could the effects of this be looked at? A: Panel could contact Jennie Matteson or Becky Hyde at IOM for re-offenders information. Q: A panel member had a query relating to the form completion by officers when a Taser is drawn or discharged.
